He is currently the Executive Chairman of Zenera Group, a strategy, PR, advertising, and investor relations conglomerate. Meka started his career in 1998 in PR and Advertising, had a three-year stint in banking, before moving to the oil and gas industry where he spent 10 years prior to founding Zenera Group in 2013. In 2014, he invested in a digital marketing start-up, BuzzDigital, and shortly afterwards, collaborated with CSR-in-Action to launch the multiple award-winning brand service, Ethica 360. Ethica 360 is a collaborative project that infuses Brand Management with best practice in the Corporate Code of Ethics, International Reporting Standards and Corporate Social Responsibility. It is a unique solution that help brands to effectively communicate often hard-to-appreciate impact investments and public social development programmes whilst embedding responsible practices.
